THE MISSION

The United Arc supports individuals and families as they seek opportunities to obtain the universal goals of community inclusion, ownership of choice, and maximizing independence.

The Family and Youth services program provides supports and parent education to parents who are living with a functional limitation who are involved with child welfare. These families learn about child development, healthy relationships, financial literacy, healthy eating, as well as accessing state services such as SNAP and disability services through the Department of Developmental Services.

The Adult and Support Services team, supports over 100 adults living with disabilities to develop the skills, confidence, and social network necessary to maximize their independence. The program assists with meal planning and prep, community volunteer opportunities, accessing medical care, financial literacy, applying for benefits such as SNAP, as well as providing social recreational opportunities.


FINANCIAL OVERVIEW FY 2024
